

PANTHER INCENTIVES

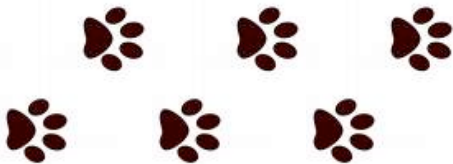
Students have many opportunities to be recognized for making good choices and following the school rules.

PANTHER POINTS

Panther Points are tickets given by any staff to students for being respectful, responsible, and ready. The Panther Point can be redeemed at the school store and is equivalent to one point. Staff members are asked to put their name on the Panther Point and give it to the student. Students must write their full name and grade on the ticket for it to be valid at PAW MART (school store).

PAW PRINTS

Paw Prints are given to students who are observed being Respectful, Responsible, or Ready. The staff person fills out the form and gives the white copy to the student to be used at PAW MART. The staff person turns in the copy in to the office. Paw Prints can be redeemed at PAW MART and are equivalent to 10 points.



POSITIVE PANTHER

The award is given monthly to one student per classroom for displaying the character trait of the month.

STUDENT OF THE MONTH

The award is given monthly to one student per classroom that has displayed academic achievement and modeled the RBES expectations of being respectful, responsible, and ready.

PAWS CALLS

Paws Calls are positive phone calls home letting a student's parent or guardian know about something special he/she has done. The student is picked up from the classroom by the Purple Panther and the parent is called.

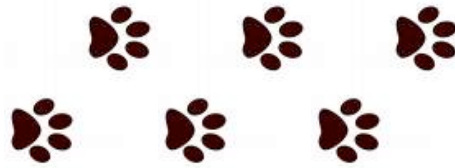

POSITIVE POSTCARDS

Positive postcards are another way for parents and guardians to learn about the great things their student has done at school.



GREEN LIGHT ACTIVITIES

Green light activities are held at the end of the day every Friday to celebrate students who have stayed on green for the entire week. Possible activities include: crafts, movies, extra recess, hat day, pajama day, etc.

PAW MART SCHOOL STORE

The school store is designed for students to redeem PANTHER POINTS and PAW PRINTS for prizes and incentives. Panther points are equivalent to one point and Paw Prints are equivalent to 10 points. Kindergarten students have a mini-Paw Mart available in the classroom. Paw Mart is open for 10 minutes during the school day. Each grade is assigned a day visit Paw Mart.

PANTHER HOLIDAYS

All students are invited to participate in PANTHER HOLIDAYS providing they have remained on green and have not received any yellow slips, red slips, or office referrals during the quarter prior to the holiday.

Possibilities for PANTHER HOLIDAYS might include a movie, a game day, a guest speaker or a field day.
